Pavilion *guidelines*

- Picnic pavilion use is for Middleton residents and their guest(s).
- Reservation requests are limited to 50 individuals and 4 hours of use maximum.
- When using barbecue grills, it is recommended that they be placed in the parking lot area with a protective mat underneath to minimize stains. If a grill is to be used in the picnic/recreation area, a protective mat must be placed underneath the grill at all times. Any damage to the facility will result in necessary charges for repairs.
- It is recommended that users bring their own chairs for use in addition to the available seating at the picnic tables.
- BYOB is defined as alcoholic beverages for personal consumption and use. Individuals may not sell alcoholic beverages, nor may they be distributed at the event for group consumption. Kegs are prohibited as BYOB.
- Individuals using the picnic pavilion for an event are responsible for cleaning up after themselves. All trash is to be picked up, bagged and placed in the trash receptacles.
