**DOG PARK GUIDELINES FOR A SAFE
AND HAPPY VISIT**



HOURS OF USE: 7AM TO DUSK.

- Middleton residents and their guests are welcome!
- Keep in mind—you are responsible for your dog's behavior at all times.
- Please wear proper attire while enjoying the park.
- Please keep dogs on a leash until entering designated off-leash areas.
- Always keep a leash with you while inside the park.
- Please wait to visit the dog park until your dog responds reliably to your voice.
- Ensure that your dog is always within eyesight.
- Dogs must be up to date on vaccinations and wear visible rabies/license tags.
- Only spayed or neutered dogs are allowed in the dog park.
- Please limit the number of dogs to 2 dogs per adult.
- Puppies under 4 months old should wait to be a bit older before joining the fun.
- Help keep the park clean by picking up after your pet.
- Please leave all dog toys at home to avoid resource guarding or squabbles.
- Only children over the age of 12 are allowed inside the dog park area.
- Residents and guests over the age of 12 but under the age of 16 must be accompanied by an adult.
- All dogs must be accompanied by someone 16 years or older.
- If your dog shows signs of aggression, please remove them right away for everyone's safety.
- Fill in any holes your pup digs during playtime before you leave.
- Save grooming or brushing for home—this space is for play!
- Food (for people or pups) is not permitted inside the dog park.
- Please refrain from smoking to keep the park smoke-free!
